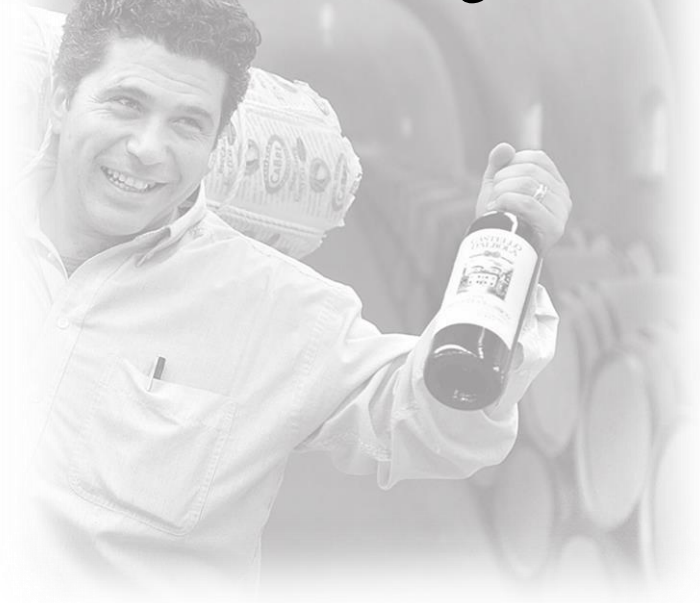
<b>Moretti Lager</b>	9.5
<b>Moretti La Rossa – Red Double Malt</b>	9.5
<b>Moretti Zero – Alcohol Free</b>	9.5
<b>Boneface – Hoptron – APA</b>	11
A superior, fruity American pale ale, with a light body and a medium bitterness. This beer tastes of citrus and stone fruit. A beer that will leave you refreshed ... yet wanting more.	
<b>Boneface – Outlaw – IPA</b>	11
This India pale ale is not your typical lager. With a huge amount of hops added to this brew to give a hoppy, yet clean, beer. Lots of tropical fruit flavours, with passionfruit dominating. A crisp, clean malt base and a lingering bitter finish.	
<b>Baladin – La Nazionale – Italian Ale</b>	13
An intentionally simple beer: Italian water, barley malt, hops, yeasts and two Italian spices (bergamot and coriander) which combine to create harmony and originality. Hoppy beer.	
<b>Baladin – Isaac – Bière Blanche</b>	13
The creamy head, the intentionally cloudy, apricot colour and the scent of yeast and citrus, which blend into spicy harmonies of coriander and peeled oranges, call you from the glass. Spiced beer.	
<b>Baladin – Rock ‘n’ Roll – Drink ‘n’ Roll Ale</b>	13
Water, barley malt, mainly American hops, yeast and pepper for an unmistakably rock ‘n’ roll character. A beer whose freshness and the skillful use of pepper blend with the aromas and bitterness of hops in a “musical” crescendo. Hoppy beer.

# Wine & Drinks



## Red Wines from Italy and New Zealand

<b>House red of the day</b> by the glass or half litre.	10/28
<b>Negroamaro – Puglia – of the house</b>	12/48
Deep colour, medium-full tannins and dark berryfruit flavours.	
<b>Marchese Antinori Chianti Riserva DOCG – Toscana</b>	14/75
Hints of blackberry and cherry. Flavours of blackcurrant and anise with hints of pipe tobacco and black pepper.	
<b>Torre Dei Beati Montepulciano – Abruzzo</b>	45
Deep, violet shaded ruby-red. Good density, typical and elegant nose. The pulpy body gives the wine a good smoothness, well balanced by the fine tannins.	
<b>JK.14 Nonno Mario Carmenère – Treviso</b>	50
From the Bordeaux variety this is a red wine with a good body and unmistakable character. When young the bouquet is typically grassy, a sensation which weakens as the wine ages.	
<b>Bixio Poderi Valpolicella Ripasso</b>	52
Medium body and complex flavour profile makes this a great pairing with a wide range of foods such as grilled meats, hearty pasta, and strong cheeses.	
<b>Montebruna Barbera d’Asti Braida – Piemonte</b>	54
Red wine from Northern Italy. It has a nose filled with red plums and currants along with a juicy palate with silky soft tannins.	
<b>Pond Paddock Pinot Noir – Martinborough</b>	55
Fine, expressive, pure with minerality. Profound with a subtleness, spicy, fruit-driven with a herbal edge giving definition to the fine red cherry fruit.	
<b>Colombo Organic Syrah</b>	58
A well-structured wine with a distinct smokiness on the nose. Nice, soft tannins, good for cellaring and a great wine with hearty food.	
<b>Riva Leone Barolo – Piemonte</b>	79
Robust with evident notes of red flowers on the nose. The palate will enjoy significant acid and strong, long, earthy finish.	
<b>Amarone Della Valpolicella Costasera Masi – Veneto</b>	99
Very dark ruby red. Smell of baked fruit, plums and cherries. Fruity tastes, with hints of coffee and cocoa.	

## Sparkling Wines

<b>Bella Modella Prosecco Extra Dry Spumante – Veneto</b>	12/42
Crisp, deliciously frothy and filled with ripe apple and citrus fruit characters with a lovely smooth creaminess. Fresh, scented, dry and grapey with a gentle texture, crisp acidity and a refreshing, soft finish.	
<b>Grasparossa Lambrusco DOC – Emilia Romagna</b>	12/45
Ruby-red colour, with low effervescence. A very full and soft bouquet, with aromas of ripe raspberry, boysenberry, and dark plum fruit.	
<b>Prosecco Col de’ Salici</b>	58
The grapes come from selected hillside vineyards in the Valdobbiadene, the denomination for superior Prosecco. White sparkling charmat met.	

## Rosé Wines

<b>House Rosé of the day</b> by the glass or half litre	10/28
<b>Pond Paddock Rosé – Martinborough</b>	55
Bright, pale strawberry-pink colour with some depth. Fine core of strawberry fruit and subtly lifted red florals along with thirst-quenching mineral elements.	

## White Wines from Italy and New Zealand

<b>House white of the day</b> by the glass or half litre	10/28
<b>Greco di Tufo Feudi S Gregorio – Campania</b>	12/48
Perfume is intense and persistent. Great depth of flavours, including white peach, Bartlett pear, and nectarine, layered with notes of Mediterranean herbs and energizing mineral.	
<b>Soave Monte Carbonare – Veneto</b>	12/48
Juicy fruit palate accented with mineral, aromatic herbs, and almond.	
<b>Pond Paddock Sauvignon Blanc – Martinborough</b>	48
Bright, light straw-yellow colour with pale green hues. Aromas of tropical fruits and gooseberries along with gentle notes of fresh herbs and mouth-watering mineral nuances.	
<b>Colombo Chardonnay – Martinborough</b>	58
Bright straw-yellow colour with light golden hues, pale on rim. Medium-full bodied and elegantly concentrated, the palate features vibrant and bright fruit flavours of white and yellow stonefruits and citrus fruits, unfolding nutty oak and flinty lees detail.	
<b>JK.14 Nonna Silvana Pinot grigio – Treviso</b>	52
A balanced and well-structured wine with a fragrant, intense bouquet with notes of jasmine and magnolia. It is fresh, zesty and harmonious on the palate, very well-balanced and has a good, persistent aroma.
